

FACTSHEET ON ADAPT and GROW CAREER FAIR FOR PMETS ON 26 JULY 2017 AT CAREERS CONNECT, OUR TAMPINES HUB

1. The Adapt and Grow Career Fair for PMETs is organised in collaboration with the North East Community Development Council (NECDC) and Our Tampines Hub (OTH). It features eight employers offering career opportunities within the proximity of the North East district.
2. Close to 80 jobs spanning the Information and Communications Technology (ICT), Facilities Management and Manufacturing sectors, offering a salary range between \$2,500 and \$7,000 are available at the one-day career event.
3. Some of the hiring positions include Business Analyst, Management Executive, HR Executive, Project Manager, Engineering Supervisor, Cost Analyst, and Accountant. Additionally most companies will be offering staggered working hours to help jobseekers balance their commitments.
4. Participating in the R³ programme are CBM Pte Ltd, Go-Ahead Singapore, Jabil Circuit (Singapore) Pte Ltd and Neurons Software Solutions Pte Ltd. WSG, North East CDC and OTH expects to attract about 100 jobseekers who are keen to work in North East District.

Jobseekers can tap on the suite of career matching services, offered by Careers Connect, that are designed to help Singaporeans develop effective job search skills, strengthen their networks and careers. Interested jobseekers may make an appointment to see a career coach for career guidance at any of the three Careers Connect at the Lifelong Learning Institute, Our Tampines Hub and Woodlands Civic Centre.
